Thank you so much for the recent donation of £42,414.54 which was received today from the Towergate Charitable Foundation.

I'm delighted to be able to confirm that this donation means the 2nd isolation room in cardiac general ward is now fully funded, an amazing achievement in a year and a half and something which all those at Towergate should be extremely proud of.

The isolation rooms form part of phase 2A of the hospital's redevelopment programme and will be based in the Morgan Stanley Clinical Building. Scheduled to open in 2012, the building will make an important difference to the lives of many patients, families and staff at the hospital. There will be facilities to support children with heart and lung conditions, children requiring neurosurgery and also children with kidney problems. Furthermore, we will have the capacity to treat up to 20 per cent more children, with more inpatient beds and day case facilities.

It is thanks to supporters such as yourselves that we are able to raise the money needed to undertake this redevelopment and continue to provide our world class care in more comfortable and appropriate facilities, suitable for our very young patients and their families.

This donation has also made significant headway in funding Dr Nick Goulden's project; which will now be receiving all future donations from The Towergate Foundation.

I understand that a number of Towergate employees have been visiting the hospital to see first hand the impact their donations will be making and also to meet Tim Milne, the biomedical scientist who is conducting Dr Goulden's research. I very much hope that they have found this interesting and would like to extend an invitation to yourself, and other Towergate employees, to visit the hospital and see the progress of the redevelopment and the work which is being conducted by Dr Goulden's team.
